Cabernet Franc. Berries & floral notes, smooth tannins with mellow and supple richness
- 51 **CHINON, Pithon-Paille, Dessus Narcay, Val de Loire, 2013** 49.00  
100% Cabernet Franc, Organic, fresh in the mouth, red fruit round mouthfeel, best with charcuterie and red meat

### BORDEAUX

- 60 **CHATEAU BELLEVUE, Cotes de Blaye, Bordeaux, 2012** 13.00 45.00  
Merlot-Cabernet blend. Aged 6 months in French oak. Very soft tannins and earthy notes, great length on the palate.
- 61 **CHATEAU SAURIAC, Plaisir de Sauriac, Lalande de Pomerol, 2012** 1/2 bot. 32.00  
Merlot-Cabernet blend, young vines, certified sustainable, round and fruity wine with velvet finish.
- 63 **CHATEAU CONNETABLE DE TALBOT, Saint Julien, , 2011** 89.00  
A well made lighter style St Julien, flavors of black currant, olive, forest floor in this dark ruby purple-tinged wine
- 64 **CHATEAU COUTELIN-MERVILLE, Saint Estephe, 2010** 85.00  
Cabernet Sauvignon 37%, Merlot 4%, Petit Verdot 17%, round texture, finish of dark cherry and earth flavors

Full, harmonious nose leading on to a smooth, rich palate with elegant black cherry fruit & supple tannins
